- 2. General Public Comment on Items Not Listed on Today's Agenda. (2 minutes per speaker)
- **3.** Discussion, possible committee action, including recommendation by consensus or vote, referring to Arleta Neighborhood Council (ANC) and Panorama City Neighborhood Council (PCNC) Boards for further action, a proposed Agreement between ANC and PCNC to fund (supplemented with matching funds from Los Angeles City Council District 6 Office) and to select and approve the design of a break-away, monument sign identifying the communities of Arleta and Panorama to be located on the northeast corner of <u>Woodman Ave & Ventura Canyon Ave</u>, just south of Branford Street, jurisdictional submittal and approval, all of which to be completed by January 15, 2013, immediately following with construction, installation and site work.

Northeast Graffiti Busters may provide insurance for the completed installation. The community sign is located at the south terminus of a commercial strip along Woodman Avenue whose eastern side lies within ANC and whose western side lies within PCNC. Design elements of the community sign: Flatness, such as square brick pilasters - is not desirable. Roundness, three dimensional relief, back-lit light emitting diodes (LED) letter illumination and use of color - are desired elements. Rough dimensions of the sign area for lettering are 48 inches vertical and 120 inches horizontal.

A separate stand-alone project proposal may be agreed to by ANC and PCNC Boards to include adjacent median landscape design and development, jurisdictional submittal and approval, construction, installation and site work. The City of Los Angeles 'Adopt-A-Median' program, as a suitable contractor, has been identified for ongoing, periodic project care, watering and maintenance. (14 min)

Discussion, possible committee action, including recommendation by consensus or vote, referring to ANC and PCNC Boards for further action, a completed request for proposal (RFP) including a preliminary not-to-exceed cost estimate from interested contractors for a community identification sign as described in Item 3 of this Agenda. A separate RFP may be submitted to interested contractors for a not-to-exceed preliminary cost estimate for adjacent median landscape development, as described in Item 3 of this Agenda. (22 min)

- **5.** Discussion, possible committee action, including recommendation by consensus or vote, referring to ANC and PCNC Boards for further action, identification of funding sources, amounts and matching fund sources and amounts required for the community sign project proposal described in Item 3 of this Agenda, meeting the preliminary not-to-exceed cost estimate from interested contractors provided in Item 4 of this Agenda.
