James Kallas read a letter written by Dianne Hand to Fire Chief Brian Cummings addressing the need for an ambulance. Fire Station 7 is the 4th busiest station in the Los Angeles Fire Department system and the busiest in the San Fernando Valley. James Kallas suggested the board endorse Dianne Hands request. Stakeholders Robert Rouge, Margaret Shoemaker, Terry Hendricks, and Joy Bizar support the motion.
