# Minutes of the Arleta Neighborhood Council General Board Meeting Tuesday, January 15, 2018

President Jaime Gallo called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.

President, Jaime Gallo led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**President's Message:** President, Jaime Gallo recognized board members for their service to the community.

### **Comments/Announcements from Government Officials:**

**Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE)** – Jose Galdamez made announcements about Empower LA Awards and Neighborhood Council Elections. He also announced that there will be a hearing for a new Restaurant Beverage permit process on January 31, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at the Marvin Braude building.

Council District 6 – Lorena Bernal announced that, in Council District 12, Greg Smith will be the acting council person until a new council person is elected. She also informed us that Councilwoman Nury Martinez has been elected President Pro Tem. Street Lighting requests now go through Bureau of Street Lighting. The process will likely take longer. Council woman Martinez is sponsoring a TOILETRY DRIVE for HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS MONTH. Toiletries to be donated to victims of human trafficking. The drive began on January 7<sup>th</sup> and ends on February 8<sup>th</sup>. There will be a community clean-up on February 9<sup>th</sup>. Lorena will contact the sergeant at the DOT regarding cars parked illegally on Woodman. She will contact

the Health Department regarding food trucks to send inspectors out to do a surprise health inspection.

**Report from L.A.P.D. Senior Lead Officer** – SLO Tracy Ware reported on street vending and food trucks. She announced that she will be happy to work with DOT regarding the problem at Filmore and Woodman. She stated that there will be an Active Shooter training coming soon. She informed us that LAPD Mission Station is having a Golf Tournament on March 18<sup>th</sup> and invited everyone to join her at Carrusel Bakery on January 23, 2019 at 10:30 am – 12:00 pm for "Coffee with the Captain." Officer Ware reported on crime in Arleta and spoke about problems with homeless encampments at Reedley and Allott. Raymond Duran presented Officer Ware with a certificate of appreciation on behalf of the Arleta Watch Dogs Neighborhood Watch.

President Jaime Gallo made announcements for Assemblywoman, Luz Rivas.

**Motion 1**/Seconded/Carried – Mary Oberg – move to approve the ANC General Board Meeting Minutes dated November 13, 2018. (Second by Loyce Lacson). The motion passed unanimously.

**Motion 2**/Seconded/Carried – Margaret Shoemaker – Move to approve the Monthly Treasurer's Report (M.E.R.) for the month of November 2018. (Second by Jesse Ramos). The motion passed unanimously.

**Motion 3**/Seconded/Carried – Margaret Shoemaker – Move to approve the Monthly Treasurer's Report (M.E.R.) for the month of December 2018. (Second by Jesse Ramos). The motion passed unanimously.

**Motion 4**/Seconded/Carried – John Hernandez – Move to approve the ANC partner with Council District 6 in a community clean-up on February 9, 2019. The ANC will provide refreshments at a cost not to exceed \$300.00. (Second by Margaret Shoemaker). The motion passed unanimously.

**Motion 5**/Seconded/Carried – Raymond Duran – Move that the ANC purchase and distribute books titled *Our Police* by Jack E. Levine for outreach to the community. The amount not to exceed \$3,500. The monies shall come from Outreach. (Second by John Hernandez). The motion passed with a vote of ten in favor and one abstention by Loyce Lacson.

**Motion 6**/Seconded/Carried –John Hernandez – Move that the ANC contribute up to \$500.00 to sponsor the Valley Alliance of Neighborhood Councils (VANC) mixer at CBS Studios in March 2019

(Second by Fernando Moreno) The motion passed unanimously.

**Budget Representative** – President Jaime Gallo announced that there is one opening for a Budget Representative for the ANC. He stated that this position is open to stakeholders as well as board members. There were no volunteers.

**ANC Board Vacancies**: Jaime Gallo announced that there are two vacancies on the ANC Board. He asked if anyone is interested in filling the following board seats:
